Dates
Sat May 24 through Mon May 26.

Safety
We recommend that you bring a hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen for daytime, and a warm jacket for the evening. Please bring all necessary items with you; there is NO REENTRY, and this policy is strictly enforced.

For the comfort and safety of all Gorge patrons, please leave these at home:

- Alcoholic beverages, cans and bottles
- Factory-sealed soda bottles
- Recording devices
- Professional cameras
- Video equipment
- All lawn chairs
- Laser pointers

But you can bring:

- Factory-sealed water bottles of "normal" size (no five gallon-type containers)
- Empty containers
- Outside food, but it must be in clear plastic bags
- Small backpacks

Doors Open
11 am. There will also be an early entry gate available for Premier Parking and VIP ticket holders.

Tickets
All tickets are general admission. Ticketmaster handles all sales (www.ticketmaster.com). Tickets are \$46.50 per day; starting Mon May 19 tickets are \$76.50 per day. (Note: No refunds or exchanges, lineup subject to change, all patrons subject to search, photo ID required for all call or guest list ticket pickups.)

Box Office
Open day of show only beginning at 9 am. Located at front gate near front entrance.

Will Call
Opens at 9 am. After the box office closes, all tickets are given to the front gate and can be picked up there until the end of the show.

Children
All ages allowed. Children under age 5 are free with accompanying adult.

Food
Enjoy the Gorge food court, featuring a great variety of food and beverages. Refreshing Coca-Cola, Domino's Pizza, and Dasani water are available as you kick back and enjoy the spectacular Gorge vista in a comfortable greenery area nestled in the vineyards. Enjoy the cooling mist in the Esurance Cool Zones.

Beverages
Beverages are available for purchase at Amphitheatre concessions and stores. Beer and wine may be purchased and consumed on-site at licensed locations only by adults displaying valid-age ID during authorized hours of operation. No alcoholic beverages may be brought onto Amphitheatre grounds.

Premium Seating
For VIP Box Sales and Superseats, call Live Nation at 425-446-4922 Mon-Fri 10 am-5 pm or visit the Premier Marquee information section at the Gorge's page on www.livenation.com. Live Nation does not sell tickets to the public, club members only.

Parking
The parking lot gates open at 9 am. The Gorge Amphitheatre has ample on-site parking. Parking areas are well marked, signed, and secure. Designated parking areas for physically challenged patrons are available (follow signage). Parking is free.

By order of the Grant County Sheriff's Department, there is no parking on county roads or private property leading to or adjacent to the park. The county ordinance also strictly prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages in the parking lot, and these laws will be strictly enforced.

Daily Rate
\$40 per vehicle per day (motorcycles or walk-in; \$20 per person/purchase on-site). NO HOOK UPS.

Three-Day Value Pass
There is now a three-day value camping pass available through Ticketmaster only for \$150. The three-day value pass is valid Sat, Sun, and Mon. We also offer a three-day value pass for the Premier camping for \$150.



Please Note: There are no rebates given for days unattended when purchasing the three-day discounted pass.

Hours
Patrons may enter campground on Fri May 23 beginning at noon; campground is open 24 hours until noon on Sat May 27. There is no entry once your vehicle leaves the campground.

Campground Rules/Policies

- No firearms or weapons of any kind
- No fireworks, open fires, or fire pits (BBQ containers are okay)
- You must possess or intend to purchase a concert ticket to be in the campground
- No drinking of alcohol in public places and roads (alcohol consumption permitted within each individual campsite)
- No underage drinking or minor in possession of alcohol
- No illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia
- No large parties, tents, or long-drinking devices
- Quiet time is observed between 2 and 9 am

There is no camping on unauthorized state wildlife areas. Do not camp along the Columbia River in these protected areas. State wildlife officers urge your cooperation.

SEATING

Accessible Seating
Wheelchair seats should be sold out of the regular general admission seating sections. A shuttle for physically challenged individuals from designated parking area takes patrons down to appropriate seating areas.

DIRECTIONS

- From Seattle:** Take I-90 east, exit #143 Gorge Amphitheatre. Follow Amphitheatre signs approximately six miles. Approximate time: three hours.
- From Spokane:** Take I-90 west, exit #149 Gorge Amphitheatre. Follow Amphitheatre signs approximately seven miles. Approximate time: three hours.
- From Quincy:** Take Highway 201 south, Beverly-Burke Road, Gorge Amphitheatre. Follow Amphitheatre signs approximately seven miles. Approximate time: 25 minutes.
- From Portland, Oregon:** Take I-84 east, Highway 97 north, I-90 east, exit #143 Gorge Amphitheatre. Follow Amphitheatre signs approximately six miles. Approximate time: five hours.
- From Vancouver, BC:** Take I-5 south, I-90 east, exit #143 Gorge Amphitheatre. Follow Amphitheatre signs approximately six miles. Approximate time: five hours.
