Schedule for the Day

Registered couples and their guests will be asked to check in starting at 2pm on December 9th, where their wedding license will be checked for completeness and accuracy. Couples will then pick up boutonnieres & bouquets, and can get their photos taken by Jenny GG Photography . Appetizers and small bites will be tray passed until it's time to line up for the ceremony at 3pm. Couples will all proceed together to begin the ceremony (*see information on the ceremony below), then recess out afterward to have Rev. Bill and witnesses sign their marriage license in the "dining room" area of the Cafe. Couples' are to provide two of their selected witnesses for signing at this time. After couples' paperwork is complete, they will be free to celebrate at the Lake Union Café & Bakery with their loved ones, enjoying more appetizers, champagne, cake, dancing and music!

Rules & Regulation

Entry to the event is based on registered couples and guests. All entry must be registered prior, including the additional guests. Valid State of Washington Marriage License required at day of check in. Couples are to provide two witnesses for signing. Registration required by December 5th. Registration closes December 5th or whenever all spots are filled.





Frequently Asked Questions

1. How to Register- Couples interested in sharing and celebrating their special day at the Lake Union Cafe & Bakery December 9th, should register and book their spots ASAP with Victoria Haberman at lucforu@aol.com or call #206-568-1258. Once you are registered, you will receive a confirmation and a helpful welcome and planning packet with detailed instructions, and directions to the venue.
2. Marriage License Info- Visit <http://www.kingcounty.gov/courts/marriage.aspx> Marriage licenses for same-sex couples are available on December 6 at 12:01am.
3. Can I attend the wedding as a spectator? We truly appreciate everyone's interest in attending this special event! Due to our facility size, the event is currently only open to the marrying couples, their guests, and a few select members of the press.
4. Do children count in the 6 guests allotment? Children 5 and under do not count in the 6 guest allotment. When registering please specify how many children 5 and under will be in your group.
5. Info on the Ceremony-Reverend Bill Wood will conduct the group ceremony. Ceremony & Reception music will be provided. A processional of the couples walking to the altar will be coordinated, timed, and cued. Each couple will process in together, spaced and paced couple by couple, and fill the area in front of the altar.
