15 INITIAL INCIDENT DESCRIPTION / NARRATIVE:

On 4/1/14 I, Ofc. Luckie #7522 was working uniformed patrol as 2F22. Iowas dispatched to Roxhill Park located at 9250 29 AV SW for the report of a male with a sawed of shotgun. The call details were as follows: ON WALKING PATH THAT ENDS NEAR BUS STOP ON SW BARTON ST, APPROX 10 MALES IN A GROUP HAD A SAWED OFF SHOT GUN, LOOKING AT GUN, NOT BRANDISHING. description provided was a group of Black males wearing red and black. I arrived in the area and conducted a search of the park with Ofc. Waters Sitting in a group on one of the walking trails and and Ofc. O'Niel. bridge were four males wearing red and black and one female. The area where the group was sitting is commonly used for narcotics and drinking due to the isolation and lack of view to the public. I recognized two of the males as and I know that they have previously admitted to being gang members (to me. While contacting the group Additional later identified as the group and wearing a red

jacket and red bandana in his pocket, stated he had a gun. I was able to see a long bulge down the front of his pants that may have been a sawed off shotgun. Ofc. O'Niel and I placed into handcuffs prior to removing the gun for safety of everyone involved. Once in handcuffs I removed a sawed off shotgun from inside the front of pants. The gun was down the crotch and right leg. I cleared the gun and made sure it was safe and pants. was advised he was under arrest for violation of the uniformed firearms act. that an illegal sawed off shotgun, barrel length of 12 inches, concealed on his person, under the age of 18, and the serial number on the shotgun and been obliterated with a tool. During the inventory search of a a billfold with a real looking badge was located. The badge looked like a county sheriff badge but was a toy Junior Yellowstone Ranger badge. 🕶 stated the badge was not his and he was only carrying the gun for somebody else but could not provide a name. was read his Miranda Warning by Ofc. Eshom #6951. understood them: I transported to the SW Precinct. The remainder of the group was identified as and the scene. Post Miranda and at the SW Precinct stated that he claimed "." I clarified with what " meant and he said same. asked him if he was still a little and he said no but still hangs out with them.

At the SW Precinct photographs of the shotgun and badge were taken by Ofc. Eshom and later uploaded via DEMS.

was also listed as a runaway/missing person. Ofc. Waters #5781 completed the required paperwork to clear the runaway under the original case number (14-82923).

The incident and arrest was screened in person by Sgt. Kuerschner #4627. was booked into YSC for investigation of VUFA.
