15 INITIAL INCIDENT DESCRIPTION / NARRATIVE:

{On the listed date and time I responded to the listed location on a report of a neighbor dispute involving a loose dog. [REDACTED] called to report that his neighbor's dog keeps coming onto his property and chasing his chicken. [REDACTED]'s backyard is kitty-corner to [REDACTED]'s backyard and there is no fence/barrier. [REDACTED] has a single chicken that lives in his backyard.

[REDACTED] reported to me the following:

[REDACTED]'s dog coming onto [REDACTED]'s property is a chronic problem and [REDACTED] makes little to no effort to keep the dog on his own property. The dog repeatedly chases his chicken and [REDACTED] is worried for it's safety and stated that he may have to resort to physical means of deterring or stopping the dog. [REDACTED] admitted that he threatened to shoot the dog if it continued coming onto his property but [REDACTED] stated to police that he wouldn't actually shoot the dog with a firearm but may have to resort to less-lethal options to protect his animal from harm. [REDACTED] stated that he got into an argument with [REDACTED] today that got pretty heated and he yelled

and cursed at [REDACTED].

I made several recomendation's to [REDACTED] including building a fence, civil litigation, or a restraining order. I gave [REDACTED] a business card.

I contacted [REDACTED] at his home and asked if he wanted to give me his side of the story. While talking to [REDACTED], his dog roamed his unfenced front yard until I asked him if he could put the dog inside. [REDACTED] was completely cooperative. [REDACTED] reported the following about the incident:

[REDACTED] tries to keep his dog on his own property as much as possible and is training the dog to be a working bird-dog but the dog manages to leave his property now and then and is attracted to the chicken. Tonight, [REDACTED] was really angry about it and yelled at [REDACTED] in front of his daughter and threatened to shoot the dog. This upset [REDACTED]'s daughter.

[REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED]'s dogs and chicken roam onto his property quite often but he never complained about it to [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] asked for recomendations and I suggested he put up a fence; [REDACTED] stated that he plans to but because of an idiosyncrasy of his property he has to get a permit from the city so he hasn't been able to yet. I also suggested that [REDACTED] keep his dog on a chain in the yard until he can get a fence up. [REDACTED] stated that he understands that if something happens with his dog he could be liable.
