On 041314 at about 0026 hrs., SPD 911 received a call from a female on a cell phone who reported a fight disturbance inside the Rose Pedals night club at 6900 ML King Jr Wy S.

On arrival, officers saw a group of females in the parking lot who were attending to another female who was down on the ground. The down female was identified as V/~~XXXXXXXXXX~~. ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ had a deep laceration to her left cheek.

As officers arrived, the majority of the patrons in the night club left, and those that remained stated they saw no fight disturbance.

W/~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ who stated she was ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~'s mother, stated her daughter was assaulted by an unknown female. She described the following:

~~██████████~~ stated she and her daughter were outside the club in the fenced seating area on the north side of the bar. She said an unknown female, the suspect, was arguing with an unknown black male. ~~██████████~~ said she thought the woman was going to assault the male with a bottle, so she stepped between them to prevent the assault. The female suspect, she said, became angry with her and pushed her away. ~~██████████~~ said her daughter came to her aid and confronted the female suspect. ~~██████████~~ said the suspect and her daughter began to fight. At some point during the fight, ~~██████████~~ said the female suspect obtained a knife and slashed her daughter across her face. She described the knife as a small folding pocket knife. After the assault, she said the suspect and her male partner fled in the listed '99 Cadillac DeVille. ~~██████████~~ was able to provide a license plate. (Wash. ~~██████████~~.)

Seattle Fire Engine 28 responded to aid ~~██████████~~. She was subsequently transported to HMC by AMR. R/O photographed ~~██████████~~'s injury. (The images were uploaded into the South Precinct Doms kiosk.)

A DATA check of the license plate given returned to ~~██████████~~. Officers responded to the address but did not locate the car.

At about 0250, ~~██████████~~ called 911 reporting that she had found a box cutter in her daughter's purse. R/O attempted to call ~~██████████~~ regarding the box cutter, but she did not answer her phone.

Sgt. Foster was advised of the assault and the severity of the victim's injury. -->}
