15 INITIAL INCIDENT DESCRIPTION / NARRATIVE:
{ On 04/13/14, at approximately 0825 hours, I (Officer Jones #7567), responded to N 50 St/Woodland Park Av N, in response to a Dog Bite call. Upon arrival I made contact with [REDACTED] (later identified as COMPLAINANT). C/[REDACTED] advised she was walking her dog (a black Russian Terrier) near the location of N 50 St/Woodland Park Av N. [REDACTED] (later identified as VICTIM) was also walking his dog (a tan Golden Retriever) in the same area, when the dogs began to wag their tails and "greet each other." Since both animals appeared friendly toward each other, both owners took no issue to this introduction. A short time later, for an unknown reason, both dogs attacked one another. Both C/[REDACTED] and V/[REDACTED] attempted to intervene and separate their dogs. In the process V/[REDACTED] was bit (it is unknown at this time, by which dog) on his forearms and hands. After both animals were separated and secured, C/[REDACTED] contacted 911 and requested assistance. SFD responded and bandaged V/[REDACTED]'s injuries on scene and transported him to Swedish Ballard for further examination. Both parties were provided with business cards and an



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incident number. V/██████████'s dog was given a courtesy transport back to their residence (8505 Ashworth Av N) by 1J31 (Officer McNew), while V/██████████ was taken to the hospital, via ambulance.
