leaving the Hooka Bar at around 0455 hrs when he saw an arm with a black handgun go up in the air and fire off multiple rounds. [REDACTED] said there were so many people he could not see who the shooter was. [REDACTED] said everyone ran in all different directions. [REDACTED] said he did not see anyone get shot at.

Subject, [REDACTED] was the driver of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said he and his friends were just leaving the Hooka Bar when they heard gunshots. [REDACTED] said he got scared and sped out of the area. Subjects, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were passengers in the vehicle. All of the passengers had the same story as the driver.

While investigating, a S&W .40 cal black handgun was discovered lying on top of a storm drain approximately 5 feet to the south of the parking lot entrance. The handgun was lying on its top with the slide locked to the rear. The handgun was recovered and was empty on recovery. The handgun was located about 100 feet from the involved vehicle in the same parking lot.

A single bullet hole was located on the right rear bumper of the involved vehicle. I asked [REDACTED] how the bullet hole got there and he said he didn't know.

A single live round was seen in plain view lying on the front passenger seat of the involved vehicle. The involved vehicle [REDACTED] was impounded to the SPD processing room for further investigation.

All of the subjects in the vehicle were identified and released at the scene, screened by 1G.

There were no victims and no property damage.

Thirteen shell casings were located in front of 12 [REDACTED] S Jackson St at the Hooka Bar. All of the shell casings were photographed and recovered for evidence along with the handgun. The handgun and vehicle were photographed as well as the entire scene.

The photographs were entered into DEMS by Officer Dentinger #6688.

[REDACTED] said the vehicle belonged to his friend so I gave [REDACTED] a business card with the case number on it along with my name and serial number.
