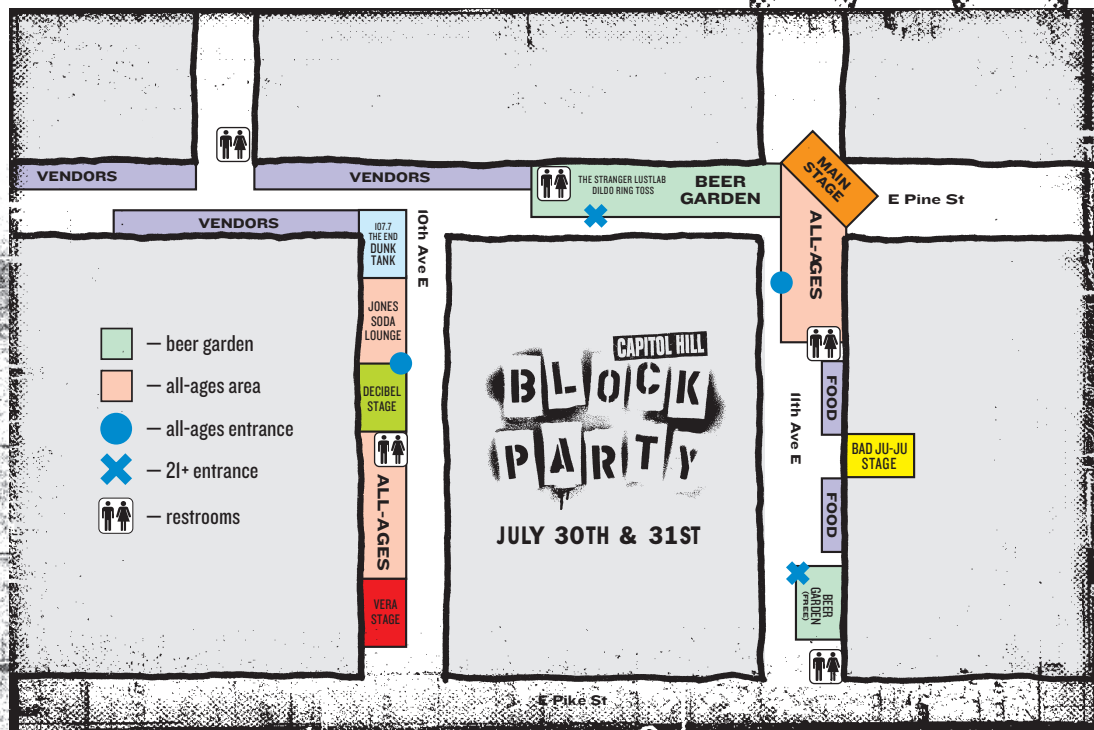

Drawing 90 acts from this region's fertile pool of producers and DJs as well as from the world's electronica upper crust, Decibel's Sean Horton and company launched an event that promises to become a must-hit fest for discerning laptop-music aficionados; indeed, 3,000 people flocked to Decibel in its first year, laying the foundation for future attendance gains.

Modeling itself after Montreal's Mutek, Decibel strives to be a multimedia platform presenting an exceptionally high level of audio-visual art and gear clinics. It makes sense for a city that's home to so much technological innovation also to host equally adventurous musicians and video artists. Gearing up for its second year, Decibel deserves to emerge from underground obscurity.
