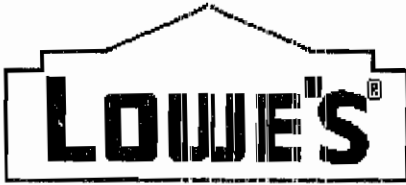
On Monday, October 25, 2010, agents from the city used a battering ram to open Will Laudanski's apartment door during a raid on his two-plant medical cannabis grow. Recognizing the error of their search, Seattle police left without arresting Mr. Laudanski, and without seizing any of his medicine. They also left his front door in disrepair, unable to fully close and lock.

The Cannabis Defense Coalition took up a collection to fix Will's door. On October 31, we sent a licensed general contractor to purchase and install a new door and associated equipment. The total cost of the materials was \$233.26. We are requesting reimbursement from the City of Seattle for this expense. Replacing Will's damaged door seems a justifiable city expense, especially in light of comments from the Seattle Police Department claiming to have done these repairs themselves.
