SeaTac Committee, by emergency motion, seeks discretionary review of the superior court decision ordering the City of SeaTac not to place an ordinance proposed by initiative petition on the November ballot because it was not supported by sufficient valid signatures. The Committee has demonstrated the grounds required by RAP 2.3(b). Therefore discretionary review is appropriate and an order should enter reversing the trial court.

DECISION

Petitioner has satisfied the criteria for discretionary review. Therefore, it is ORDERED that the motion for discretionary review is granted. We reverse the trial court, vacate the trial court's August 26, 2013 order, and quash

all writs issued pursuant to that order. An opinion providing written reasons for this court's decision will follow in due course.
