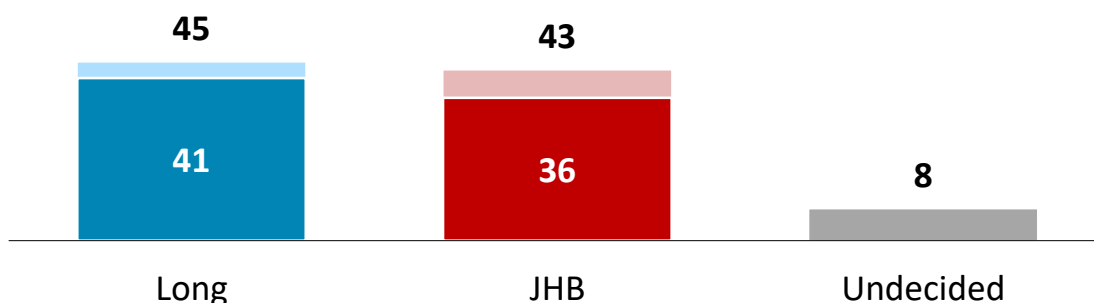

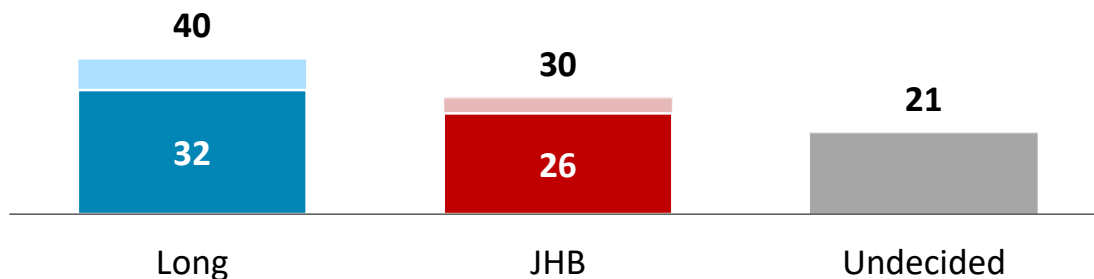
The new Lake Research Partners poll of likely general election voters in Washington’s 3rd Congressional District shows Democrat Carolyn Long narrowly leading incumbent Republican Jaime Herrera Beutler by two points.¹ The race has shifted in Long’s favor since June, when she trailed Herrera Beutler by six points.²

Ballot



Among self-identified independents, Long leads by a 10-point margin, with 40% of the vote to Herrera Beutler’s 30%. In terms of favorability, 44% of independents have a favorable impression of Long and only 15% have an unfavorable impression. Forty-two percent of independents have a favorable impression of Herrera Beutler, but 41% have an unfavorable impression of her.

Ballot – Among Independents



Long’s highly effective message has put her campaign in a strong position to compete and win this seat in the final three weeks.

¹ Lake Research Partners conducted a live telephone survey among 400 likely November 2018 general election voters in Washington’s 3rd Congressional District. The survey was conducted October 9-11, 2018 and has a margin of error of +/-4.9%.

² The previous survey was conducted June 14-18, 2018 among 500 likely voters in WA-03.
