Call screened on scene by Sgt. Watson #5160

A/██████████ was arrested and booked to KCJ for Investigation of Assault.

On 04-29-2011 I was working in a marked patrol vehicle as unit 2-Ocean-1. At Approximately 1717 hours I was flagged down at the ██████████ at 4th Ave S and S Lander St. I immediately updated dispatch of my location. I pulled my patrol vehicle west bound on S Lander St. While in my patrol vehicle I observed what appeared to be a physical fight disturbance breaking apart with two main parties involved. I advised radio. Several other units answered up and stated that they were en route to my location.

I observed two vehicles that appeared to be related. I saw a man in a red sweatshirt, later identified as Subject/██████████ throw what appeared to be a yellow baton onto the ground. Sub/██████████ then joined two other men and got into a white SUV. I updated radio of the weapon being tossed and updated the two license plates over the air.

Dispatch then advised over the air that one of the subjects had a knife in his possession. Dispatch updated the suspect information with a name of ██████████.

Ocean sector units are familiar with a B/M transient named ██████████ matching the description who goes by the alias of ██████████. Unit 2-Ocean-02, Officer Ortiz #6092, arrived with me and we then approached the disturbance. Officer Ortiz and I gave verbal commands to all subjects involved with our duty weapons from the low ready position to get on the ground. Subjects complied. I advised radio to hold the air. Officer Ortiz and Unit 2-Sam-32, Officers Pirak and Martin extracted the remaining subjects out of the white SUV. Radio was updated that we had 5 on the ground. I then advised units en route to slow down.

Other units arrived and identified all subjects. All subjects not involved in the physical altercation and who returned clear were released from the scene.

A witness/██████████ saw the disturbance take place. In his statement, he claimed that a B/M suspect, later identified as Arrested/██████████, threw his back pack at the white SUV. W/██████████ stated the driver of the car, V/██████████, got out and stated that he did not want any problems. W/██████████ stated that A/██████████ then started to swing at V/██████████. W/██████████ stated that V/██████████ blocked the strikes that A/██████████ swung on V/██████████. W/██████████ stated that A/██████████ then walked over to a car, that was no longer at the scene at the time of Police arrival, and produced a knife. A/██████████ then came after V/██████████ and his associate, Sub/██████████ with a knife and was "swinging wildly."

V/██████████ had no visible injuries and stated that he was not hurt. Sub/██████████ also had no injuries.

A/██████████ and Sub/██████████ were taken into custody and transported to the

South Precinct for further investigation. Sgt. Watson #5160 screened the arrests on scene.

Officer Ortiz took a written statement from W [REDACTED] Sub [REDACTED] was released from the South Precinct. Sgt. Watson screened the release.

The Victim [REDACTED] was uncooperative and was unwilling to give a statement. V [REDACTED] was given a Seattle Police Business card with incident number and informed to call Police if he changed his mind to provide a statement.
